Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Note

An Associate is a layperson who has made a commitment to the charism of a religious community. Both Associates and Sisters are called to the same mission and charism, yet they are distinctly different. Where Sisters take perpetual vows to live out the charism in religious community, Associates hold individual vocations to live out the charism, but do not take vows.

On July 9th, 1987, the Sisters of St. Joseph in London approved the movement towards having an Associates Program complete with a candidate process and formal training process. The program began on April 4th, 1989, in London, Ontario. The Associates Program was originally founded by Sister Doreen Kraemer and later administered by Sister Janet Zadorsky. After Sister Janet Zadorsky ended her involvement with administering the Associates Program, as of April 2017, two associates were given stipends by the Associates to serve as mentors for two years, during a bridging stage. They prepared a document, "Midwives to Our Future," and after this, the Associate program evolved away from the Sisters being directly involved. The program is now autonomous but still connected through a Congregational liaison, but the Associates make their own decisions.

The Associates Program currently (as of 2022) has an Associate Leadership Circle with a representative from each of the areas: London, Sarnia, Windsor-Chatham, Simcoe-Woodstock, and Zaña, Peru. There are Animators for each region who assist with spiritual development. There is a Core Team who look after business matters, including event planning. Together, these form the Joint Animating and Core Team. Every leader has a term of two to three years. There is also a congregational liaison who provides a communication channel between the Associates and the Congregational Leadership Circle. Members are recruited by means of a "seekers" process and are provided with instruction and allowed to discern their commitment over a two-year period, at the end of which there is a "charism connection" ceremony, and they are given a pin and sign an agreement. There are two annual events held: a retreat, and the Annual

General Gathering. As well, there is a representative who attends Federation meetings of Associates from Hamilton, London, Peterborough, Pembroke, Toronto, and Sault Ste. Marie.

Scope and content

This sous-fonds contains directories, newspaper clippings, financial records, correspondence, presentation talking points, photographs, photo albums, promotional materials, a survey, handbooks, crafts, history timelines, meeting minutes, and reports. These records relate to the administration and operation of the Associates Program.

The records in this sous-fonds were transferred from the Associates office to the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph in Canada archives in the summer of 2019.

Scope and content: This series contains various directories and Associate lists. Notably, there are three albums which are larger booklets that contain photographs of members, divided by city. There are agreements from 1995-2012 between the Associates and their directors but these are for Associates who have subsequently withdrawn from the program. There is also correspondence indicating the withdrawal of two Associates from Yellowknife, NWT.

Scope and content: This series contains volumes 1-50 of the newsletter “Bridging” spanning from 1991-2016 and produced by the Congregation’s Associate Core Team (ACT) members. Two volumes were published each year, usually in the winter and summer, but sometimes in the fall and spring. This newsletter was intended to inform people about the Associate relationship in the Congregation and to keep the Associates up to date with news about events. Each newsletter has its own theme, such as, service, relationship with the Divine, and longing for belonging. Common sections throughout the newsletters are poems, “mark your calendar” sections, suggestions for readings, news about events, fundraisers, and retreats, introduction of new members, and updates from various Associate communities. These communities include Maidstone, St. Thomas, Windsor, Chatham, Kingsville, Woodstock, Simcoe, London, Grand Bend, and Sarnia. Also included is a coloured drawing of a bridge that is crossing a small creek with trees and other flora surrounding it that was made for the newsletter.

Scope and content: The Charism Connection is the ceremony that involves laypeople taking vows to be guided by the charism of the Sisters by which they become Associates. There is a commitment ritual in which the incoming Associates pledge to pray and offer love, commit to continual spiritual growth through personal prayer, and join the congregation's mission of working to achieve unity of neighbour with neighbour and neighbour with God. In return, the Sisters pledge to accept and

welcome the Associates, offering them prayers, and encouraging them in spirit. Ceremonial materials such as invitations, agendas, and correspondence regarding commitment are included within this subseries. This subseries also features a questionnaire for potential Associates that determine the readiness for the commitment ceremony and a copy of the mutual agreement for the Associate's relationship between the potential Associates and the Sisters. There is also sheet music of hymns that were sung during the Charism Connection ceremonies. The commitment ceremonies took place in both Windsor and London, Ontario.

Scope and content: This series consists of mostly booklets, correspondence, and two photographs related to the Associates program in Peru. Canadian Associates worked in collaboration with the Associates in Peru to live out the charism through charity work, seeking solutions to environmental, economic, political, social, and spiritual challenges. The Agrégée is a status in between that of vowed members and Associates and they commit to practicing a discerning life that is open and responsive to the movement of the spirit; commit to the spirit of poverty, chastity, and obedience according to their personal situation; participate in congregational meetings; make a financial investment in the community according to their personal situation; attend regular retreats; and attend to her spiritual life. There are still many unknowns about the program; it is an organic, evolving model. This series contains information on the Agrégées program, including the constitution for canonical and non-canonical members comparing the two roles, a history of how the Agrégées program came about, and an interview with two Sisters from 2011 regarding the program.

Other materials in this series include information about mentorship Animators. The Animators are senior Associates who have been committed Associates for at least three years. Included in this series are administrative materials detailing the roles and responsibilities of Animators, and how to select and endorse Animator and Associate Animator candidates. Also included are lists of nominees for these positions, and the final lists of the chosen Animator and Associate Animators.

This series also includes both Congregational leadership and Associate leadership correspondence and minutes of Leadership Team conference calls.
