Biography: Conrad Payling Wright was born in Middlebrough, England. Nothing is known about his family or early life. He appears to have served in the Royal Garrison Artillery in World War I. In 1924 Wright married Esther Isabelle Clark (1895-1990) of Saint-John NB, who became a well-known Maritime historian. After their marriage, she followed Wright to Stanford University in California where he was studying. Coming from a well-established family, she was able to pursue her historical research full-time. She lived in Wolfville NS, while Wright spent much of his time in Ontario. They were still married when she died in 1990. C.P. Wright accepted her posthumous Order of Canada award in 1990.

Wright was the author of "The St. Lawrence Deep Waterway: A Canadian Appraisal" (1935) about the unratified 1932 treaty between Canada and the US to build a deep waterway to connect the Great Lakes to the Atlantic and the benefits that it would provide. Using his accumulated research material as a base, Wright continued to collect a wide variety of information on what became the St. Lawrence Seaway, opened in 1959 and the associated hydroelectric developments. He planned to write a book on the Seaway, but this never came about. Wright did give a number of talks about the Seaway as well as making a number of presentations to various groups interested in the project. He died in 1991.

Custodial History: C.P. Wright left this material with Library and Archives Canada in the late 1960s but it was never processed. The material was transferred to CMST in 2015.

Scope and Content: The fonds consists of a large collection of printed material relating to the St. Lawrence Deep Waterway/ St. Lawrence Seaway, 1894-1969. It also contains Canadian and American federal, provincial/state, regional and municipal descriptions, reports, and submissions. There is also material

from associations including American pro and anti-St. Lawrence Seaway lobby groups. There are articles from newspapers, magazines and other publications about the Seaway and its costs/benefits. There is also Wright's manuscript, galley and reviews of his book "The St. Lawrence Deep Waterway: A Canadian Appraisal" (1935) as well as chronologies and Wright's talks and submission about the Seaway. There is a small amount of Wright's correspondence, mostly asking for information about the Seaway. Lastly, there are special newspaper sections about the Seaway as well as maps and oversize documents. The fonds is arranged in five series.

Notes:

Related Archival Material: Library and Archives Canada has a large amount of material on the St. Lawrence Seaway from numerous government departments, including the St. Lawrence Seaway Authority fonds (R1195-0-X-E). The Seaway is well documented in other archives with published and audio-visual media.

Notice biographique: Conrad Payling Wright est né à Middlebrough, en Angleterre. Aucune information n'est connue concernant sa famille ou son enfance. Il semble d'avoir servi dans la Royal Garrison Artillery dans la Première Guerre mondiale. En 1924, il a épousé Esther Isabelle Clark (1895-1990) de Saint John, au Nouveau-Brunswick, qui est devenue une historienne maritime réputée. Après le mariage du couple, elle a suivi son mari à l'Université Stanford, en Californie, où il étudiait. Issue d'une famille aisée, elle a pu poursuivre son travail de recherche historique à temps plein. Plus tard, elle a habité à Wolfville, en Nouvelle-Écosse, alors que son époux passait la majeure partie de son temps en Ontario. Les deux étaient encore mariés au moment du décès de l'historienne, en 1990. Conrad Wright a accepté la reconnaissance de l'Ordre du Canada qui a été décernée à Esther Clark Wright à titre posthume, en 1990.

Conrad Wright est l'auteur de l'ouvrage *The St. Lawrence Deep Waterway: A Canadian Appraisal* (1935) qui porte sur le traité non ratifié de 1932 entre le Canada et les États-Unis concernant une voie navigable en eau profonde entre les Grands Lacs et l'océan Atlantique, et sur les avantages qu'une telle voie maritime pourrait procurer. Prenant appui sur ses vastes résultats de recherche, Conrad Wright a continué

d'assembler de l'information forte variée sur ce qui est devenu la Voie maritime du Saint Laurent en 1959 et sur les projets hydroélectriques qui en ont découlé. Il prévoyait écrire un livre sur la nouvelle voie maritime, mais ce projet n'a jamais vu le jour. Il a toutefois donné plusieurs conférences sur le sujet et a fait plusieurs présentations auprès de groupes intéressés. Wright est décédé en 1991.

Portée et contenu : Le fonds comprend une grande collection de documents imprimés concernant la Voie maritime profonde/Voie maritime du Saint-Laurent, de 1894 à 1969. On y trouve des descriptions, rapports et soumissions des gouvernements canadiens et américains, de niveaux fédéral, provincial, étatique, régional et municipal. Le fonds contient également des documents d'associations, dont des groupes de pression américains favorables ou contre la voie maritime. On trouve en outre des articles de journaux, de revues et d'autres publications traitant de la voie maritime et des coûts/bénéfices du projet, ainsi qu'un manuscrit de Wright, des épreuves et des critiques de son livre *The St. Lawrence Deep Waterway: A Canadian Appraisal* (1935), en plus de chronologies, de présentations et de soumissions de Wright portant sur la voie maritime. Le fonds comprend quelques lettres de Wright, la plupart demandant de l'information sur la voie maritime. Enfin, on trouve une collection de coupures de presse, de cartes géographiques et de documents de grand format. Le fonds est classé en cinq séries.

Documents reliés : Bibliothèque et Archives Canada conserve une grande quantité d'archives sur la Voie maritime du Saint-Laurent provenant de plusieurs ministères, y compris le Fonds de l'Administration de la voie maritime du Saint-Laurent (R1195-0-X-E). La Voie maritime est également bien documentée dans des autres archives en termes de documents publiés et archives audio-visuels.

Series Descriptions

Series 001. Personal, 1930-1965, 17 cm of textual records, Box 001.

Wright's manuscript, galley and reviews of his book "The St. Lawrence Deep Waterway: A Canadian Appraisal" (1935) plus a small number of his later talks and submissions about the Seaway. Chronologies of improvements to the St. Lawrence River. Correspondence with the Sergeant-at-Arms about getting copies made of documents relating to the Beauharnois scandal of the 1920s and his attempt to enlist in 1939. Wright's general correspondence 1947-1965, generally asking for information or commenting on the Seaway.

Series 002. International Joint Commission, 1922-1956, 20 cm of textual records, Box 001-002.

Applications to and reports by the IJC regarding the St. Lawrence Deep Waterway/Seaway. A copy of a major report in 1926 which laid the foundation for subsequent work. Canadian application to start development unilaterally in the early 1950s. In the early days the IJC was often dependent on the Canadian or American governments to publish its reports.

Series 003. Canadian Seaway Documents, 1894-1969, 95 cm of textual records, Box 002-005.

Federal, provincial, municipal and private sector articles, descriptions, reports and submissions relating to the St. Lawrence Deep Waterway/Seaway project. Numerous publications from federal government departments, royal commissions and Parliament. Publications from provincial governments, mostly relating to Ontario hydroelectric developments along the St. Lawrence. Publications from municipal boards of trade, bureaus, and harbour commissions. Also articles from Canadian publications and pamphlets about the waterway.

Series 004. American Seaway Documents, 1903-1960, 80 cm of textual records, Box 005-007.

A range of St. Lawrence Seaway-related documents from federal, state and municipal governments, US national, regional and local associations and from the private sector from the first half of the twentieth century. Of particular interest are pro and anti-Seaway associations which tried to influence federal government policy over several decades.

Series 005. Newspapers, Maps and Oversize, 1940-1964, 13 cm of textual records and 14 maps, Box 008-009.

Canadian and American press clippings concerning the St. Lawrence Seaway 1948-1961, special newspaper sections devoted to the Seaway, particularly from the late 1950s. Various maps of the St. Lawrence Deep Waterway/Seaway 1940-1959. A few oversize publications 1951-1957.
