The territory occupied by the Church was divided into Annual Conferences composed of all ministers within its jurisdiction having been received into full connexion and an equal number of elected laymen. The Conference became the Manitoba Conference in 1904.

Series includes minutes of Annual Conferences and Ministerial Sessions, 1908, 1916, 1921; records of the Missionary Committee and Conference Pastoral Address, and unverified microfilm of other Conference records and of the Winnipeg Ministerial Association.

<u>SERIES 2: RECORDS OF THE DISTRICTS. – 1887-1929. – 40 cm of textual records. – 9 unverified</u> microfilm reels : positive and negative.

The territory occupied by each Annual Conference was divided into Districts. Each Annual District meeting consisted of all ministers and probationers for the ministry within its bounds, and an equal number of lay delegates, elected by the Quarterly Official Meetings, for each minister or probationer in the active work from each circuit, mission, or station in the District. A Financial District Meeting was held in each District every year to apportion money to the circuits, to examine the missions and recommend apportionments, to arrange the claims of children of ministers and to levy the amount to be raised by the circuits and missions for the Superannuation Fund, and to make arrangements for Missionary and Educational Meetings.

Series includes minutes of the Annual Meetings/Ministerial Sessions and/or Financial District Meetings, and other records of the following Districts: Birtle, Brandon, Calgary, Crystal City, Dauphin, Deloraine, Morden, Neepawa, Port Arthur, Portage La Prairie, Saskatchewan, Swan River, Winnipeg (original); Carman, Edmonton, Lake Winnipeg, Moosomin, Pembina and Turtle Mountain, Rainy River, Regina, Roland, Souris, Wesley College, Winnipeg North, Winnipeg South (unverified microfilm).

Unverified microfilm records are also available for the Districts of Birtle, Brandon, Calgary, Crystal City, Dauphin, Deloraine, Morden, Neepawa, Port Arthur, Portage la Prairie, Saskatchewan, Swan River, Winnipeg.

See also the Saskatchewan Conference records since some of these records, such as Moosomin and Regina, are continued there.

Brandon, Souris and Deloraine Districts were part of the Assiniboia and Saskatchewan Districts after 1904 for a number of years but all holdings of these Districts are listed here.
