UNITED CHURCH OF CANADA SUPPORT TO LOCAL MINISTRIES UNIT FONDS. – 1990-2011. – 4.70 m of textual records. –74 photographs.

The Support to Local Ministries Unit was one of six working units created in 2001 that brought together work from the former Division of Mission in Canada and from the former Department of Stewardship Services following the restructuring of the General Council Office.

The unit was mandated to provide denomination support that enables, develops, and celebrates the vital and holistic ministries of diverse local church bodies (congregations, institutions, and specialized ministries) across Canada. Its work was divided into three programs, namely: Mission through Finance Program, Congregational Mission and Church Development Program and Specialized Ministries Program.

While Aboriginal Ministries was originally coordinated by the Division of Mission in Canada, due to the restructuring, oversight of Aboriginal Ministries was transferred to Support to Local Ministries. In 2006, Aboriginal Ministries, including the Healing Fund, migrated organizationally to report to the General Council Minister, Racial and Gender Justice. Aboriginal Ministries Council is now its own unit in The United Church of Canada.

In 2007, the Support to Local Ministries Unit and Faith Formation and Education Unit combined to form the Congregational Educational and Community Ministries Unit.

Fonds consists of the following series: Minutes (2002-2006), Records re Institutional Relations (1990-2010), Records re Mission Through Finance (1992-2010), Specialized Ministries (1999-2009), Aboriginal Ministries (1997-2009), Faith and Sexuality (2004-2005).

SERIES 5\Subseries 3: Records re Healing Fund

While the Healing Fund was originally coordinated by the Division of Mission in Canada, due to the restructuring, oversight of the Healing Fund was transferred to this unit, which worked with Aboriginal Ministries. In 2006, Aboriginal Ministries, including the Healing Fund, migrated organizationally to report to the General Council Minister, Racial and Gender Justice. The Healing Fund Council now reports to the Aboriginal Ministries Council (2009-current).

Records re Healing Fund Council

The Healing Fund Council comprises of representatives from Native United Church congregations across Canada, and meets twice a year to disburse funds to Aboriginal communities' projects, based on various guidelines. At the 35th General Council (1994), the Bay of Quinte conference presented Petition No. 112 entitled "Fund for Healing- Native People of Canada". The original text for the petition originated with the Division of Mission in Canada Residential School Advisory Group. It was resolved by the General Council that a "Fund for Healing" be established with the initial goal of raising \$1 million over a four year period (1995-1998), and that all efforts of the Healing Fund be coordinated by the Division of Mission in Canada. The Healing Fund had a Technical Implementation Group, which was established in British Columbia to take advantage of the expertise gained in that Conference through the successful effort of the B.C. Land Claims Fund. The TIG provided oversight of strategic planning and production of campaign materials. With the completion of the mandate of the DMC Advisory Group, the TIG continued

to be accountable for the Healing Fund directly to the DMC Executive. The fundraising period was extended in 1999 as the monetary goal had not been raised. In November 2004, the General Council Executive affirmed the work of the Healing Fund Council and re-mandated its work of discerning which local projects best fit the goal of healing and cultural restoration in First Nations communities. The executive also approved a position to staff the Healing Fund. It continues as one facet of the United Church's ongoing reconciliation work with Aboriginal people.
