I am lick to be where I am thowever Le has not gone as yet I they are not certain whether they are goin mas yet but will know definitely by to-night. I am trying to get away hope I succeed. The weather weather to - stay is quete cold & have had few scattered snow fulls. Have not seen any Jepps as yet nor de gresques
